The data is classified according to : 1) type of pollution, 2) business category, products, 3) technique of pollution control, and treatment methods, 4) improved effects, 5) costs of improvements, 6) operation year, etc., .

Although specific names, such as locations and polluters are not available, the case file provides core information (including indicators) in the relevant projects.
